**2020 CDBG
Street Paving
Project**

The City of Poplar Bluff held a public hearing on Monday, July 17, 2023 in the Council Chambers at 301 South 5th Street this hearing was held to discuss the past performance by the City in carrying out the City's 2020 Community Development Block Grant for Street Paving. The project included the purchase of materials to improve roads along and adjacent to Abington, Bradley, and Center Streets, Clare, Cyde, and Marion Avenues, as well as North Riverview Drive. The Poplar Bluff Street Department provided the labor to pave the streets as their in-kind match contribution toward the grant. All interested citizens and groups were encouraged to attend the hearing.

City Manager Matt Winters addressed the Council and stated this public hearing is part of the grant process.

Ozark Foothills Regional Planning Commission Project Administrator Rachel Coleman appears before the Council and reviewed the Street Paving Project with them.

Street Superintendent Jerry Lawson appeared before the Council and stated this was a much needed project for the City and it went well.

There were no comments made by the public regarding the 2020 Community Development Block Grant Street Paving.

There being no further business to come before this public hearing of the City Council, motion was made by Mayor Pro Tem Jerrica Fox, seconded by Councilwoman Lisa Parson and carried that this public hearing be adjourned.
